



## 2016 Evergreen Speedway Tire Rules

### **Super Late Models:**

Approved tires are the Hoosier 3035 left and 3045 right purchased from Evergreen Speedway. At no time are softener, additives, chemicals, enhancers or strengtheners to be applied to any tire. You must qualify and start the main event(s) on the same set of tires.

### **Street Stocks and Mini Stocks:**

Approved tires are the Hoosier 700 and must be purchased from Evergreen Speedway.

You may have six new tires in inventory to start the season. All tires will be recorded at the first race you compete. You may enter one new tire into inventory every other race after the the first race you compete in and it must be raced on the event it is entered into inventory. No Stockpiling

Any new driver competing after the season opener will have to start at the back of the heat and main.

Qualifying tires must be used to run the all heats and the main event(s).

At no time are softener, additives, chemicals, enhancers or strengtheners to be applied to any tire.

If a recorded tire is damaged or deemed a safety hazard the driver must present the tire to the Tire Official on the day the tire is damaged and get approval before purchasing or replacing the tire.

Tires go with the driver. If a car change is made, the tires must be switched and the car number changed to reflect the correct driver.

**Outlaw Figure 8:**

Approved tires are the Hoosier 3045 and must be purchased from Evergreen Speedway. Take Off 3045 Hoosiers are allowed and MUST be purchased from Hager Motorsports.

You may have six new tires in inventory to start the season. All tires will be recorded at the first race you compete. You may enter two new tires into inventory every other race after the first race you compete in and it must be raced on the event it is entered into inventory. No Stockpiling.

Run Off Rule - Outlaw Figure 8 are allowed to run their Nutread tire through the 4th of July race. They will need to be on the Hoosier 3045 after that

**Super Stock Figure 8:**

Approved tires are the 8" Towel City Retreads and are only available for purchase from Hager Motorsports. No Rain Tires.

Run Off Rule - SSF8 are allowed to run their Nutread Tires Through the 4th of July race. They will be required to run the towel city retreads after that race. Once you purchase Towel City Tires you must run them at every event.

**Stinger 8:**

Any Dot approved tire meeting the following specifications. Minimum 60 series side wall. 400 tread wear. Falken Azenis are also approved.

**Hornets:**

Any DOT approved tire meeting the following specifications. 60 series or larger. 400 or higher tread wear. Speed rating of H or less. Each tire must have tread showing tread across the entire face of the tire. Be commercially available for purchase for less than \$65.00 each including shipping. Excludes close outs, discontinued or other discounts not available to all racers.
